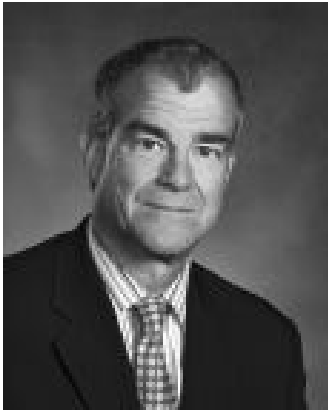


## Edwin (Ed) Baird Wainscott
